
- Genres: Poetry, non-chronological report, mystery narrative

- Punctuation: Hyphens, dashes, semi-colons, colons, commas, ellipses. List punctuation
- Composition: Creating cohesion within and between paragraphs through the use of conjunctions, adverbials, repetition and pronouns. Identifying and using different levels of formality to suit the purpose of the writing
