English:


We will be looking at the books 'The Snail and the Whale' and 'The Lonely Beast'

Maths:

Number: Place value (within 10)

- Count to ten, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number
- Count, read and write numbers to 10 in numerals and words.
- Given a number, identify one more or one less
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations

Addition and subtraction

- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10
- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs
- Add and subtract one digit numbers to 10, including zero
- Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction
