A blue tracksuit to wear on top of their PE shorts, if necessary, for the colder weather . KS2 : Trainers for outside games and for the winter Football Boots (plastic studs or blades only) and Shin pads. Gum shield recommended for hockey. Year 1 and 2 :Trainers for outdoor use

Coat	Plain Navy or Embroidered with School Logo
School Fleece	Navy Embroidered with School Logo
Alternative coats may be worn.	

Please ensure all uniform is clearly labelled.

P.T.O

Long hair must be tied back. If hairbands or ribbons are worn to keep hair back, these should be blue or white.

Jewellery

Jewellery is not allowed in school. If absolutely necessary, plain small gold or silver ball studs may be worn in pierced ears but **must** be removed for all PE including swimming. Larger earrings, or other designs are not permitted on health and safety grounds. Watches may be worn, but must be removed for PE lessons.

Make up and nail varnish is not to be worn in school.
